FRIDAY IS OUR NEW RECYCLE COLLECTION DAY

Dear Residents,

We were just informed today that, **beginning November 1**st, **our <u>recycling</u> collection day changed from Tuesday to Friday.** Unfortunately, our trash company, Republic Services, overlooked providing us with advance notice. In any event, we hope everyone can easily adjust to the new schedule. **Trash will continue to be collected on Tuesdays and Fridays.**

A few reminders:

- Trash and recycling should be placed out for collection no earlier than dusk the evening before collection day.
- Do not place loose trash or recycling on the ground.
- Do not place plastic bags in recycling container.
- Cardboard should be broken down before placed in container.
- Bulk items are not automatically collected. If you have a bulk item to dispose of, please contact Republic Services by calling 215-744-2995 to make arrangements for pickup. The resident requesting the service is responsible for any associated bulk fee (if applicable), not the Association.

Please recycle only the items below.



✓ PLASTICS

Recycle plastics #1 thru #7. Look on the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.



✓ METAL CANS. ALUMINUM FOIL. **ALUMINUM FOIL PANS**

Recycle all food and heverage metal cans steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.



✓ CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER AND **MAGAZINES**

You can also include newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books & brochures.



✓ PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS

Recycle fourthoxes including juice boxes, egg, ice cream & milk cartons, and cereal & pasta boxes.



√ PAPER

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards & file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.
