IMPORTANT CHANGE

FRIDAY IS OUR NEW RECYCLE COLLECTION DAY

Dear Residents,

We were just informed today that, **beginning November 1st, our recycling collection day changed from Tuesday to Friday.** Unfortunately, our trash company, Republic Services, overlooked providing us with advance notice. In any event, we hope everyone can easily adjust to the new schedule. **Trash will continue to be collected on Tuesdays and Fridays.**

A few reminders:

- Trash and recycling should be placed out for collection no earlier than dusk the evening before collection day.
- Do not place loose trash or recycling on the ground.
- Do not place plastic bags in recycling container.
- Cardboard should be broken down before placed in container.
- Bulk items are not automatically collected. If you have a bulk item to dispose of, please contact Republic Services by calling 215-744-2995 to make arrangements for pickup. The resident requesting the service is responsible for any associated bulk fee (if applicable), not the Association.

Please review and keep handy the enclosed holiday collection schedule and the recycling information flyer. **Please also check-out the trash company's website to review more detailed information about what items are and are not permitted in your garbage or recycle container;** www.RepublicServices.com

Be sure your recyclables are **EMPTY, CLEAN** and **DRY** before placing them in your recycling container.

Dry.

One dirty item can contaminate thousands of pounds of collected materials. Make sure your items are empty, clean and dry before placing them into recycling containers.

These items should **NEVER** be placed in your recycling container.

Batteries
Bubble Wrap

Electrical Cords

Stuffed Animals
Styrofoam

How can we make recycling better together?

Please recycle only the items below.



✓ **PLASTICS**

Recycle plastics #1 thru #7. Look on the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.



✓ **METAL CANS, ALUMINUM FOIL, ALUMINUM FOIL PANS**

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans - steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.



✓ **CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINES**

You can also include newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books & brochures.



✓ **PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS**

Recycle food boxes including: juice boxes, egg, ice cream & milk cartons, and cereal & pasta boxes.



✓ **PAPER**

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards & file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.
